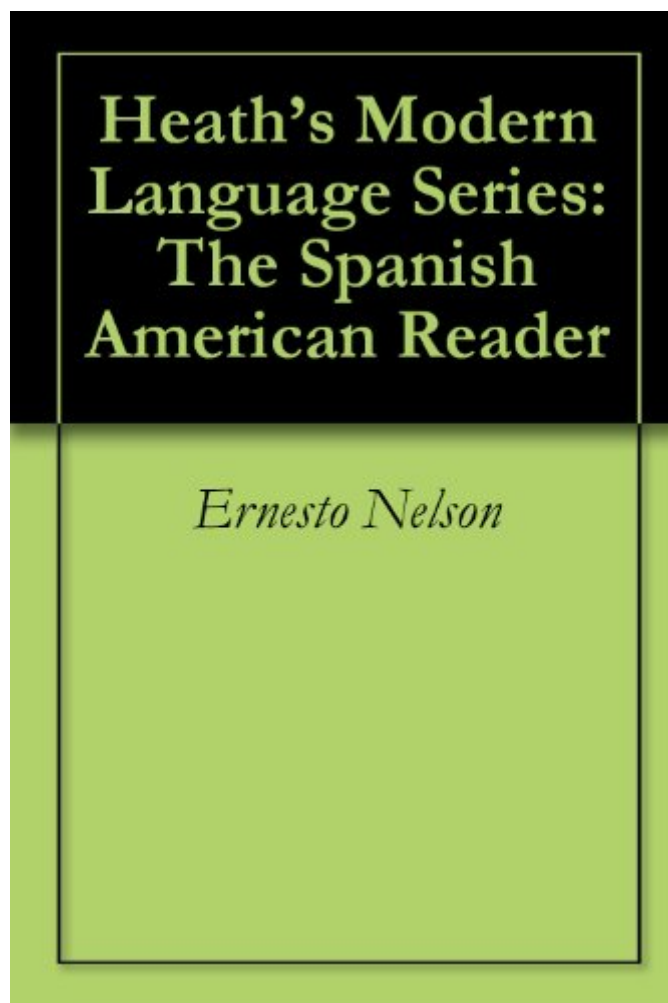

The whole purpose of reading this book is to practice, practice, practice one's Spanish when one is

learning the language. The vocabulary and grammar are at the right level for someone who is approaching intermediate level. Not suitable for absolute beginners. The stories are not that interesting though, but the more interesting stories tend to be at a higher level of Spanish, so it achieves the objective.

I try to casually practice Spanish. The elementary readers are great. This is a bit too advanced, with a minimal glossary. It deals with pretty obscure topics like how to buy real estate and design a house in South America (in 1916). I'm plodding through it, but not so much fun.

It is free and one can never get enough practice reading Spanish. The stories are easy to follow even if you do not have a full grasp of the vocabulary.
