

The protagonist, Frank, is very funny and uses a lot of film references in his narrative. He's very likeable, self effacing but with a hint of arrogance. The other characters are interesting and and well described, even the lesser ones. The story jogs along at a good pace, lots of action with magical battles as well as all out gunfights. It kept me glued to the pages throughout the fighting. The ending

was full of surprises and left me hanging, ready for the next book in the series. Over all a good collaboration for these two authors, one of whom is new to me. 4.5 out of 5.*This was an ARC from the author, my opinions are my own.*

This is a weird, funny book. The Hero, Frank, has an ego the size of Texas.But then the action starts and you try to forget about that ego, but he's the one that keeps bringing it up.I think men would really get a kick out of this book!

This book just didn't do it for me. I enjoyed most of the snark of the main character but a lot of the book just seemed to formulaic for me. For one thing why reference la Corazon in Spanish everytime. Why don't they just call it the Heart? And for another I am pretty sure it would be el Corazon not la. For another why did they put this super powerful artifact in some random guy to save his life when the faction needed it to stop the Enders? I guess you could make the argument that since the Heart tends to kill people the mages saw an opportunity at no risk to themselves to implant it in someone but that doesn't seem to fit the Doc's personality as revealed so far. This book was also very short and if you don't have Kindle Unlimited I don't see it being worth \$2.99. If it stays at \$.99 then sure you could give it a try and not feel too bad if you don't like it, but there are way better books you could be spending your money on. Some parts of the book, including the humor and snark of the MC just seemed way to forced sometimes, kind of like some of the humor in the new Ghostbusters.Overall, the book was mediocre. I would say give it a try if you are searching for something to read, you may like it. Just don't expect to be wowed and you won't be disappointed.

I received an ARC in return for an honest review. I love JA Cipriano's other series so was really excited to see this collaboration. Frank Butcher, like other characters in Cipriano's other series, is snarky, full of one liners and at times the dialogue is very tongue in cheek. Throughout the book there are references to movies and TV shows. Frank also has "The Collection" of old movies that is destroyed by the anti magic Enders. I also loved the double meaning of the title. Aside from La Corazon beating in his chest, Frank, truly does have a heart of gold. This is a fast paced book, full of action, both gunfights and magic fighting. Frank is very similar to Mac Brennan, but looks better in his delivery uniform! I really enjoyed this book and it kept me turning pages, but I hate cliffhanger endings leading into the next book. This book is resolved before the cliffhanger and Cipriano has a penchant for throwing these endings into his books. I still gave it 5 stars because I do love the story and Frank's character. It is hard to say too much without giving spoilers. If you don't mind foul

language & like a main character full of snarky one liners, you will like this one! Looking forward to seeing more from this pairing.
