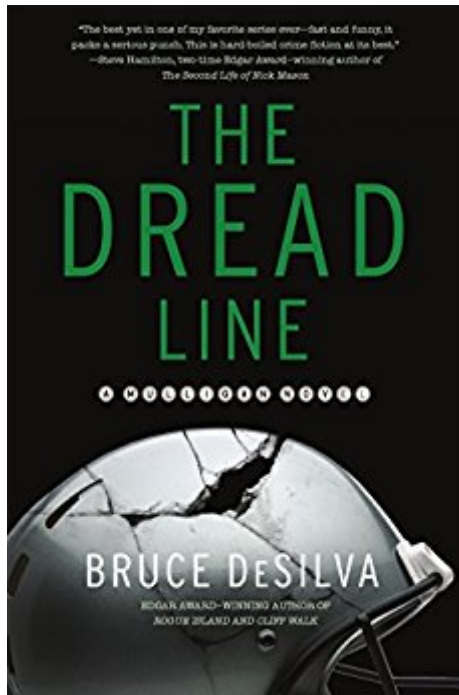

I look forward to the latest entry in any detective series I follow as I look forward to an extended visit with an old friend. It's an opportunity to find out what he's up to, how life is treating him. I've particularly enjoyed following Bruce DeSilva's Mulligan for the past six years. He's got the down-to-earth voice and tough guy sense of humor that's been drawing readers to the genre since the days of Raymond Chandler. But Mulligan earned his voice, and his cynical worldview, through decades as an investigative reporter in Providence, Rhode Island — a city that makes Chandler's Los Angeles look like a genuine city of angels. Mulligan's long-time employer, the Providence Dispatch, was dying when the series began. He lost his job there in the series' fourth entry, *A Scourge of Vipers*. DeSilva dangled a number of future careers before his hero as that book wound down. A private investigator he'd often worked with offered him a partnership in his agency. A former protégé from the Dispatch wanted his help with a startup news website. And his bookie wanted Mulligan to take over the operations so he could retire to Florida. Full disclosure: I'm a reporter by trade. I'm roughly the same age as Mulligan. Knowing the state of journalism, it's nice to know what other job options there are out there. *The Dread Line* starts with Mulligan in better financial shape than we've seen him in to date. He's now working all three jobs. His cut of the bookmaking operation has helped him buy a Ford Mustang and a house in Jamestown, south of his old stomping grounds.
