When I opened this book and realized it has been written by a 14 year old I was excited to see that someone so young has been published, but my standards for the poems weren't set too high. I expected the poems to have originality and passion but it felt like she was just taking whatever she

looked at and started writing it down. Some poems are pretty good though, I'll give her that. It's a pretty short book also, so I wouldn't get it if you're expecting a long term book to take on a trip or something.

I've already read this book over 5 times. There is a poem for every emotion and feeling. Mae is so talented and I look up to her so much as a teenager myself. I find that this book really explains what I can't even put into words myself.

I had high hopes for this book, even after reading mixed reviews. I gave it the benefit of the doubt, but I was disappointed after the first couple of pages. I didn't even finish the book. It lacked depth, meaning, and didn't really evoke any emotion, except boredom, though a handful of stanzas and poems were insightful--not much really stood out.
