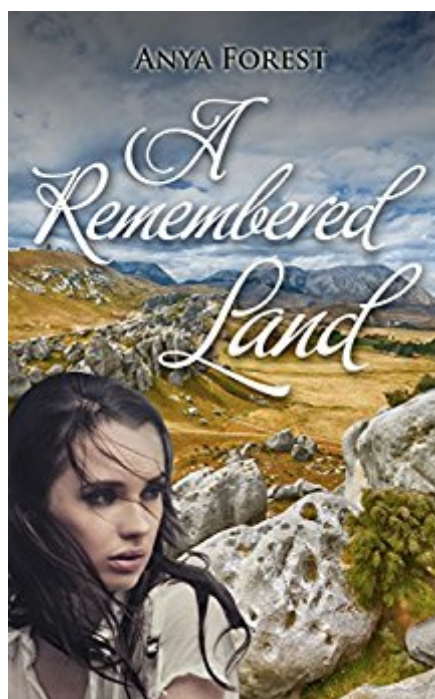

I found this an unusual book. In the very beginning I wasn't quite sure where the story wanted to go... But I soon got into the rhythm and found that the story flowed. I liked the characters--Louise was quirky, but also impatient and sometimes sounded younger than her age. Cody was at times too good to be true but also a terrific counterpart to Louise. I noticed that the author was extremely good in writing dialogs, I could actually see the person talking . I guess my biggest critic would be that the land was not described much, that a lot of the time it could have been anywhere and not just in New Zealand. I would have liked to hear more about geology that Cody and Louise were suppose to be studying especially what has to do with the places that they visited.
