

The Stephen King Companion by George Beahm is a beautifully crafted monster of a book (nearly

600 pages!) that will please any King fan! Readers can purchase either a softcover/paperback edition, or a sturdier Hardcover edition (advertised as a "Library binding edition"). Both editions are identical, but the hardcover has sewn in pages (Smyth-sewn) that will certainly please libraries, being super durable. Also a plus is the fantastic artwork by Michael Whelan and Glenn Chadbourne!

If you want to know anything about Stephen King, here's your guide. Put in Concise readable, easy to understand format, you'll be able to find out anything at a glance. Or for you die-hard such as myself, reading from beginning to end is a Joy! You'll find out many new things you didn't know and correct many things you thought you knew. I really wanted to like this book. It's long, almost 600 pages, but each of his major books gets 1-2 pages each, and what's written doesn't illuminate the books/stories much at all. In a book this big there should be more information for example on one of King's nearly 700 page books than a one page write up that's not quite a review. On the subject of Stephen King's accident in 1999, the author tells you to read King's book "On Writing" rather than going into details. However he takes many pages to discuss King's band the Rockbottom Remainders. The author's interest in Stephen King is obviously different than my own. I have several "companion" type books like the Twilight Zone companion which has a good write up on every episode. This companion book is a mishmash of bits and pieces about King and his books but it meanders. The definitive Stephen King companion would be great. This book is not it.

Anything by George Beahm on the subject of Stephen King is going to be great. This book is fun to read and doesn't disappoint.

It was a very useful guide to his works and a great connection to his personal life.

Gave this as a gift but am considering getting a copy for myself. Looked through it briefly and it looks amazing! very interesting and seems laid out very well.
