

There is no plot to this book. The words are simple (usually no longer than five letters) and the illustrations are full of color and vitality. Basically, children from all different cultures express what they like in the world by saying, "I love you, ____ (fill in the blank). For example, "I love you, fish"; "I love you, sun". The book, though as infantile as it is, has a subtle message about caring for others and the environment. Infants and young toddlers seem to enjoy this book, but I wouldn't recommend it to anyone over the age of two.

My 3 year old autistic son learned to say "I love you" because these words are repeated on every page with a different noun; for example "I love you, sun" then "I love you, sheep". It's MY favorite

children's book (and now his, too), so he heard me read these words a hundred times. BRAVO! to Ms. Pandell for having the foresight to write such a simple, fascinating, and educational book!

I absolutely love Tomie dePaola's artwork, especially the way he depicts children, and this book is no exception. (Growing up with the Christmas tale "Old Befana") was my first introduction to his art.) The illustrations have both the vivid and saturated color that make them look modern, while also conjuring up a sense of a bygone era from traditional folklore. I think the illustrations would be appealing to children. The text is very simple. Each page shows a child in an outdoor setting telling something he/she loves it. "I love you, sun" for example. In turn, each different child loves a sun, a sheep, the wind, a tree, a bird, a fish, a flower, a rabbit, a rock, a bug, stars, water, a wolf, the moon, and the earth. The cast of children is ethnically diverse. I sometimes buy the English/Spanish version of children's books if the text is so simple that I can't quite justify buying the book, or if I can't imagine wanting to read it hundreds of times. The Spanish keeps it interesting for me, and I think it provides a good developmental opportunity for my son. Note that this book is small (5 1/4 by 5 3/4 inches) and rectangular, while the English-only version is much bigger and cut in the shape of a heart.

I love this book--I was so glad when I ran across it. A very sweet sentiment and nicely done illustrations. The repetition will help a small child learn Spanish.

A simple book all about loving everything around you. What could be easier to share with a little one. My daughter loved this book from 2 months! The illustrations are fantastic, a favorite of ours!

Really cute book for my bilingual 2 year old granddaughter. She really enjoys sitting down for story time either with me (for the English version) or her other grandma (for the Spanish version)! Great idea to put this in both languages, just for this reason!

It is cute. Based on the title, I was hoping for more about the sun and moon specifically. Each page just says "I love you ____" and includes a wide variety of natural objects. Not a book for someone looking to share a book about the sun or moon, though.

This starts out with "I love you sun" and includes I love you water, rock, bug, wolf, and other things found in our natural world. It finishes with "I love you earth and you love me." Exactly the message I

was looking for. Update: I bought this book for my LO when she was an infant. She is now almost 2 and still enjoys it. However, it is no longer one of the books she demands to read (even though in general ANY book with the moon in it is a hit). I think she is starting to outgrow board books as she's now into Dr. Seuss, Richard Scarry, and the complete Night Before Christmas. So, I think the suggested age range of 3-5 years is WAY off. I would say this is for babies/young toddlers. I would like to find a book with a similar message for her level, would appreciate any suggestions!
